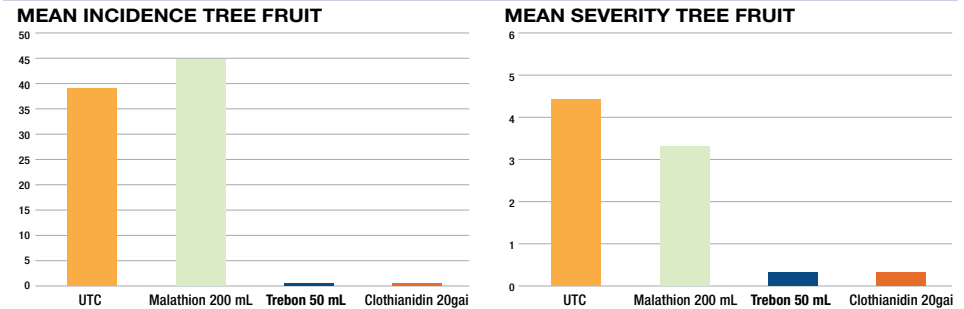

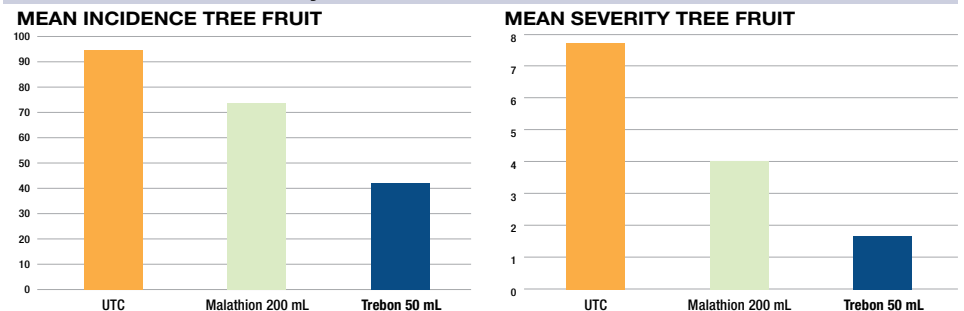
CROP	INSECT PEST	RATE	WHP	CRITICAL COMMENTS
Stone fruit (except cherries)	Queensland Fruit Fly (<i>Bactrocera tryoni</i>) and Mediterranean Fruit Fly (<i>Ceratitis capitata</i>)	50-100 mL/100L	3 days	Spray to wet foliage and fruit to near the point of run-off when adult fruit fly numbers warrant spraying. Trebon will not control eggs or larvae present in fruit at spraying. Use the higher rate for heavy infestations. If re-application is needed, a minimum of 7 days is required between treatments. Do not apply more than 3 applications per season.

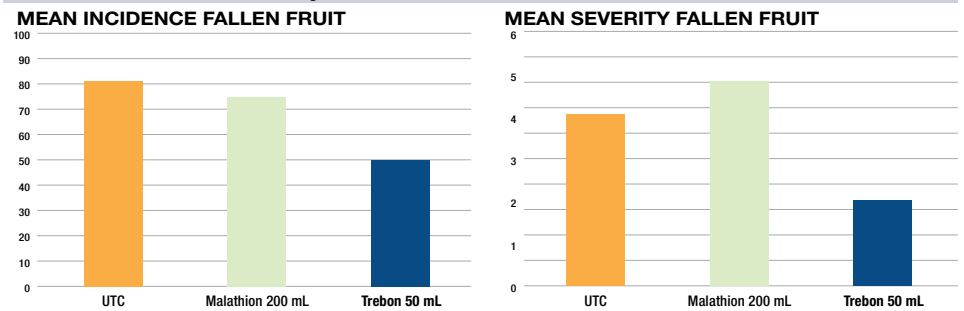
